**Friday, June 19 – St. Romuald (951/2-1027):** Romuald was born at Ravenna, Italy, of a noble family around the year 951. When his father killed another man in a duel, Romuald was so affected that he retired to a Benedictine monastery. He remained there for three years, and with the abbot's permission, he moved to the vicinity of Venice and placed himself under the direction of a hermit. For the next thirty years Romuald travelled extensively throughout Italy, founding monasteries and hermitages. In 994 he returned to Ravenna and eventually, in 1012, he founded what was to become the Camaldolese Order of hermits. He died, alone in his cell, at the monastery of Val di Castro.
